Meeting called to order by Ben - KD5DCN 11 Members were present

TREASURERS REPORT: Checking - \$11,387.64 Savings - \$5,156.62, Total - \$16,544.26. Detailed report is attached.

#### **General Discussion Items:**

Tech Committee Update: Westside repeater update. Chris did a restore to get repeater back into service, root cause for last week's outage unknown. He will need to look at logs to see if he can determine cause.

Corrales Space Update: Ron and Chief are working through the concerns about donating to non-profit and impact in getting a repeater at the fire station in Corrales.

Duke City Hamfest - will be Sept 20-22, should the group sell items from our Connex at the fest? Item to be discussed in further detail next month.

Trailer Update - SWR is high on the antennas in the trailer. Gary will be taking a look at the grounding and will see if he can remedy. Discussion on battery bank and what size to proceed with. General vote was to all progress with build efforts to include all work needed with solar, battery and radio elements being last as we will be seeing if the county will be able to offer any assistance.
